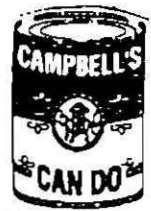

Niemeier, Neva Parks, Shirley L'Heureux, Dennis Erickson, Steve L'Heureux, Tori Karr, and Pat Choquette.

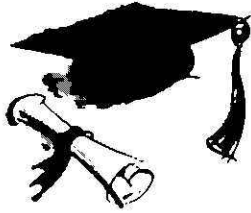
